HAIR TRANSPLANT – WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW!

It is a surgical procedure. During the process, the surgeon will harvest the donor follicles from one part of your scalp like the back of your head. Remember that the back of your head is genetically resistant to baldness. After this, the surgeon will move to the recipient site wherever you have a hair loss. Remember that you don't have to go to the hospital for a hair transplant. This is an outpatient procedure that uses the local anesthetic to numb your scalp. Depending on your requirements, you might have to take multiple sessions. On average 1000 to 4000 follicles are transplanted per session that requires several hours.

HAIR TRANSPLANT SURGERY- FUT VS FUE

Two types of hair transplant are:

- Follicular Unit Transplantation (FUT)
- Follicular Unit Excision (FUE)



Follicular Unit Transplantation (FUT):

This is strip surgery that includes the harvesting of the small patch of skin that will be divided into smaller units. After this, they will place the unit into the incision on the recipient site before they close the wounds.

Follicular Unit Excision (FUE):

This involves the transplanting individual hair follicles with a punch tool. This procedure is more intensive for a surgeon but it is less painful for the patient. This method has less downtime and it also carries no risk of scarring.



HAIR TRANSPLANT- THIS IS BEST FOR?

It is important to keep one thing in mind that not every person is the right candidate for a hair transplant. If you have extensive hair loss and you have few donor hairs available, then your surgeon will not be able to provide you the desired results. It will be the decision of the doctor to find out whether you fall into this category or not! They will use the Norwood scale for the assessment of your hair loss. The same thing goes for hair loss due to conditions like alopecia or due to certain medications.

Moving on, the people with tight scalp or fine hair might have to struggle with hair transplantation. On the other hand, people with coarse, wavy hair or a loose scalp will see positive results. Age is also an important factor that needs to be considered when you are planning to go for a hair transplant. If you are young, then you will require multiple operations as your hair will lose with the passage of time.

Expected Results

The results of a hair transplant are different. 90% of the transplanted hair will grow properly. A person has to wait for three months to see the results. Furthermore, most people will get 60% of hair growth nine months after the procedure.

The best transplant will look like your real hair whereas the poor procedure will leave give you an uneven hairline, donor deletion where many hairs have been taken from the donor site.

To make your hair transplant success, you should follow all the procedure instructed by your doctors:

- Applying a dressing to transplanted follicles,
- Avoid the use of shampoo for a minimum of 24 hours
- Sleeping upright for a minimum of three nights. This is important because this will ensure proper blood flow to the hair follicles.

What About Side Effects?

After the treatment, you will notice swelling and bruising along with red dots at the place of donor follicles. You might have tenderness and aches at the sight of transplant.

Shock loss is an important side effect. This happens when all the donor hairs fall out after the three weeks of operation. But this is completely normal and this does not mean that the procedure has failed. Remember that your entire hair follicle has been transplanted it is not just the hair. Due to this, the new hair will replace the hair you have lost.

You need to be ready for the shaved look for a few weeks. The hair transplant is a surgical procedure, infections, allergic reactions, and excessive bleeding can occur. There is no need to worry because this will be treated by the doctor. FUT might leave scarring & is not recommended.



FINDING A GOOD CLINIC

PRICE OF HAIR TRANSPLANT

The cost of your hair transplant will depend on the different factors. This will include the session you need and the type of surgery you are going to select. FUT has a flat fee. The clinic will charge per follicle in the case of FUE. For the right cost, it is best to visit the clinic and get the estimate after a conversation with the doctor you have chosen for treatment.
